- Be at the ground 30 mins prior to start of play
- Everyone does some scoring and umpiring
- Full cricket whites must be worn, including club shirt and cap (white wide brim hat is also acceptable)
- Always respect the umpires decision
- If there is wet weather assume your game is on
- Go directly to the Union Hotel after the day's play – The Union are our sponsor and under our arrangements we must support them!

After match each week all players are expected to be at the Union between 6.30pm and 7.30pm for the weekly reading of the scores and 'mug of the week'. Attendance is compulsory.
